- 5. Review of General Education Learning Outcomes Grids: Dr. Eftink indicated that he would begin to review whether courses entered into General Education Learning Outcomes grids have the corresponding learning outcome in the course syllabi.
- 6. The Committee discussed the need to gather evidence from departments on how they were assessing critical thinking.
